Penguins I Found



■ **Gentoo**

Patch of white from eye to eye

Size: 30 in (76 cm)

Weight: 12–14 lbs
(5.5–6.4 kg)



■ **Rockhopper**

Red eyes with yellow crests at each eye's edge

Size: 16–18 in
(41–46 cm)

Weight: 5–6 lbs
(2.3–2.7 kg)

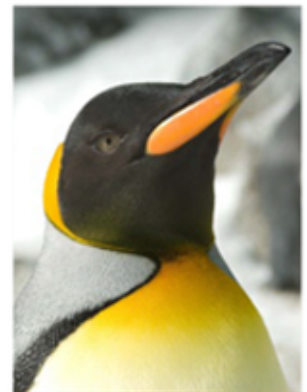


■ **Adélie**

Almost all-black head with white eye rings

Size: 24 in (61 cm)

Weight: 8–10 lbs
(3.6–4.5 kg)



■ **King**

Big orange ear patch shaped like a “teardrop”

Size: 37 in (94 cm)

Weight:
30–35 lbs
(13.5–16 kg)

Behavior I Observed

- Penguins scratching with their beaks or using their feet to get to hard-to-reach areas of the head
- Penguins sleeping standing up
- Penguins sleeping lying down
- Penguins huddling to stay warm
- A penguin pointing its beak and extending its head toward another penguin (this usually means, “You’re too close!”)
